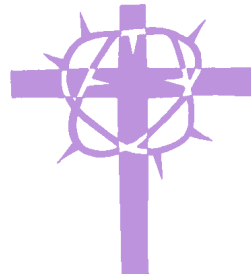

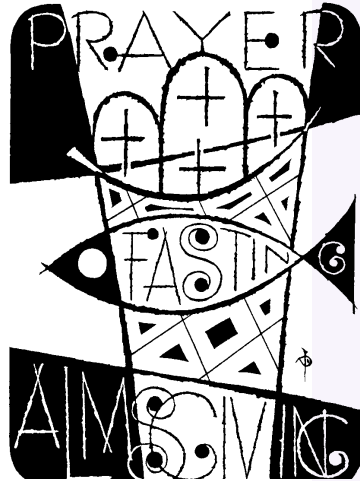


Pastor's Corner

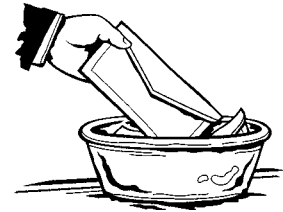

How to Become EIM Compliant: New Applicant

We are all *Called to Protect*.

REQUIRED steps to complete the EIM process for all new applicants:

1. Submit (one time only) an EIM Application for Ministry prior to volunteering; or for new employees, within the first week of employment (a condition of continued employment). Submitting the EIM application (available online and in a paper version) permits the Diocese of Austin to run a background check and also creates an account for EIM administrators to record your workshop history. All sections of the application must be completed in order to submit it; incomplete applications are deleted out of the database periodically.

2. Attend a three-hour EIM Basic Workshop (within 60 days of application submission) that teaches participants about boundaries, warning signs, appropriate interactions with minors and vulnerable adults, how to respond to incidents and reviews diocesan EIM policies. [Note: New Applicants who have verification of previous workshop attendance in a different diocese may submit that verification to the EIM Office for review. This previous training may be able to serve as applicant's "Basic"; they then need to attend a Refresher workshop to review diocesan policies and procedures and sign the Code of Ethics form.

New Applicant only - will sign up for a workshop after submitting your application. Click on How to Sign Up for a Workshop.

3. You should check your own EIM account periodically to view the status of your application and verify that your workshop date has been recorded, or contact your parish/school office for assistance. You will not be contacted by the EIM Office unless there is an issue with your application or background check.

How to report an incident of concern

The Diocese of Austin is committed to preventing harm from happening to any of our children or vulnerable adults. If you are aware of sexual or physical abuse and/or neglect of a child or vulnerable adult, state law requires you to report that information to local law enforcement or the Texas Department of Family and Protective Services at (800) 252-5400 or www.dfps.state.tx.us. Additionally, if the suspected abuse is by clergy or an employee or volunteer of any diocesan parish, school or agency, a Notice of Concern should be submitted to the diocesan Ethics and Integrity in Ministry Office at (512) 949-2400. The Notice of Concern can be found at www.austindiocese.org (click on the link HOW TO REPORT ABUSE). Reports may be made anonymously.



Cómo Ser Obediente con EIM: Nuevo Solicitante

Todos Estamos Llamados A Proteger.

Pasos necesarios para completar el proceso de EIM todos los nuevos postulantes:

1. Presentar (sólo una vez) un EIM Solicitud de Ministerio antes de voluntariado; o para los nuevos empleados, dentro de la primera semana de trabajo (a condición de conservar el empleo). Presentación de la EIM aplicación (disponible en línea y en versión papel) permite la Diócesis de Austin para ejecutar una comprobación de antecedentes y también crea una cuenta para los administradores de EIM registro su taller historia. Todas las secciones de la solicitud debe ser completada con el

fin de presentarla; las solicitudes incompletas se eliminan de la base de datos periódicamente.

Nuevo Solicitante - Solicitud de Ministerio se puede encontrar en www.austindiocese.org

2. Asistir a tres horas en un taller básico EIM (dentro de los 60 días de presentación de la solicitud) que enseña a los participantes acerca de los límites, las señales de alerta, las interacciones con los menores de edad y adultos vulnerables, cómo responder a los incidentes y los exámenes las políticas diocesanas EIM. [Nota: Los candidatos nuevos que tienen verificación de la participación en los talleres anteriores en diferentes diócesis podrán presentar que la verificación de la oficina de EIM para su revisión. Esta formación previa puede ser capaz de servir como solicitante de "Basic"; tienen que asistir a un taller de Actualización para revisar las políticas y los procedimientos diocesanos y firmar el Código de Ética.
3. Usted debe verificar su propio EIM cuenta periódicamente para ver el estado de su solicitud y comprobar que su taller fecha ha sido registrado, o póngase en contacto con su parroquia/oficina de la escuela de asistencia. Usted no debe ser contactados por la oficina de EIM a menos que haya un problema con la aplicación o verificación de antecedentes.

Cómo reportar un caso de abuso

La Diócesis de Austin está comprometida a la prevención del daño que se cause a cualquier niño o adulto vulnerable. Si usted está enterado del abuso sexual o físico y/o abandono de un niño o adulto vulnerable, la ley estatal requiere que se reporte esa información a la policía local o el Departamento de Servicios Familiares y de Protección del Estado de Texas al (800) 252-5400 o al sitio: www.dfps.state.tx.us y además, si la sospecha de abuso es por parte del clero, empleado o voluntario de cualquier parroquia, escuela u organización de la diócesis, se debe enviar un Reporte de Abuso y debe ser presentado a la Oficina de Ética e Integridad en el Ministerio de la diócesis al (512) 949-2400. El Reporte de Abuso se encuentra en nuestra página de Internet diocesana: www.austindiocese.org (Haga click en la liga COMO REPORTAR UN CASO DE ABUSO). Estos reportes pueden ser hechos de manera anónima.

The Potta Divine Retreat Ministry is part of the renewal movement of the Vincentian Congregation of India, based on the spiritual traditions bequeathed by St. Vincent de Paul.
