PASTOR'S CORNER / ESQUINA DEL PÁRROCO

December 8th - Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception
(Holy Day of Obligation)

On December 8, we celebrate the Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception of the Blessed Virgin Mary, which references Mary's conception in her mother's womb without the stain of Original Sin: An essential part of God's plan for the mother of his Son was that she be conceived free from Original Sin. "Through the centuries the Church became ever more aware that Mary, "full of grace" through God, was redeemed from the moment of her conception" (CCC, no. 491). In anticipation that she was to bear the Son of God, Mary was preserved from the time of her conception from Original Sin.

We call this the Immaculate Conception. No sin would touch her, so that she would be a fitting and worthy vessel of the Son of God. The Immaculate Conception does not refer to the virginal conception and birth of Christ, but rather to Mary's being conceived without inheriting Original Sin.

In the course of time, the doctrine of the Immaculate Conception became more precisely enunciated, as its truth—long supported by the universal popular devotion of the faithful—was better understood by deepening theological inquiry. In 1854, Pope Pius IX proclaimed this dogma infallibly: that is, in his role as supreme teacher of the Church, he declared that this doctrine is divinely revealed and must be accepted with faith by the entire Church. (United States Catholic Catechism for Adults, 142-143)

8 de diciembre - Solemnidad de la Inmaculada Concepción
(Día Santo y obligatorio)

El 8 de diciembre, celebramos la solemnidad de la Inmaculada Concepción de la Santísima Virgen María, que hace referencia a la concepción de María en el vientre de su madre sin la mancha original Pecado: Una parte esencial del plan de Dios para la madre de su hijo fue que ella ser concebida libre del pecado Original. "A través de los siglos la iglesia se convirtió cada vez más consciente de que María "llena de gracia" por Dios, fue redimido desde el momento de su concepción" (CCC, no. 491). Previendo que iba a tener el hijo de Dios, María fue preservada de la época de su concepción del pecado Original.

Esto llamamos la Inmaculada Concepción. No hay pecado tocarla, así que ella sería un recipiente apropiado y digno del hijo de Dios. La Inmaculada Concepción no se refiere a la concepción virginal y el nacimiento de Cristo, sino más bien María ser concebida sin la herencia de pecado Original.

En el curso del tiempo, la doctrina de la Inmaculada Concepción se convirtió en enunciados más precisamente, como su verdad — larga apoyada por la devoción popular universal de los fieles — se entiende mejor por profundizar investigación teológica. En 1854, El Papa Pio IX proclamó este dogma infalible: es decir, en su rol como maestro Supremo de la iglesia, declaró que esta doctrina es divinamente revelada y debe aceptarse con fe por toda la iglesia. (Catecismo Católico de Estados Unidos para los adultos, 142-143)
