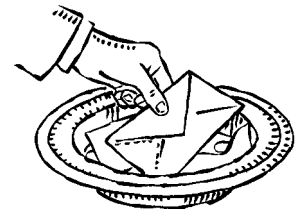

PASTOR'S CORNER

October – Respect Life Month

Last weekend was the beginning of “Respect Life Month” in which we are reminded of the importance of the dignity of the human person. In today’s gospel Jesus cures ten individuals who have leprosy yet only one of the ten returns to give thanks and praise to God. Leprosy was not only a serious disease of the flesh, it was contagious and deadly and for this reason they were not only considered “unclean” but were also social outcasts. In Jesus’ time people with this disease were considered to have been punished by God for a sin they committed or by their parents. Jesus showed compassion and mercy to these individuals and cured them of the disease and restored their human dignity. We could say that the leprosy of today are those individuals who have been marginalized, alienated from within our families, the parish community and society; the poor, the sick, the elderly, same sex attraction, the list can go on. As Jesus showed mercy and compassion to the marginalized of his era and restored their dignity, we are reminded to do the same. Let us pray to the Lord and ask him to show us to be merciful and compassionate to those who have been marginalized beginning within our families and parish community. The respect and preservation of the dignity of the human person in all stages of life is at the heart of the gospel.

Altar of Remembrance

We will have the Altar of Remembrance this year in the foyer of the main church. Beginning the weekend of October 22nd all are welcome to bring a picture of their loved ones and place it on the altar. The altar will remain through most of the month of November up to the weekend prior to the First Sunday of Advent. Please use the following guidelines:

- 1) Pictures must be in a picture frame no larger than 5” X 7” (anything larger will be removed).
- 2) Must have a label behind the frame with name of the deceased.
- 3) Must have the name and current/valid phone number of the owner of the picture in back of the frame.

Como Jesús mostró misericordia y compasión a los marginados de su época y restauró su dignidad, se nos recuerda de hacer lo mismo. Oremos al Señor y pedirle que nos muestre a ser misericordioso y compasivo a aquellos que han sido marginados dentro de nuestras familias y comunidad de la parroquia. El respeto y la preservación de la dignidad del ser humano en todas las etapas de la vida están en el corazón del Evangelio.

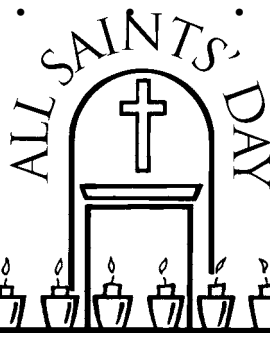
