Steps for Confession

1. Make the sign of the Cross while saying: “Bless me Father for I have sinned”
2. Confess your sins. (Example: I have been unkind or mean.)
3. Be sorry for your sins and LISTEN to the advice of the Priest.
4. Say the Act of Contrition.
5. LISTEN to the words of ABSOLUTION that the priest will say.
6. After leaving the Confession Room kneel before the Altar, say your “Prayer after Confession”, and do the penance the Priest has given you.
